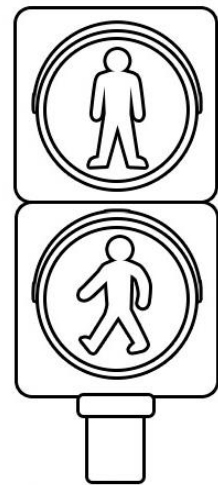
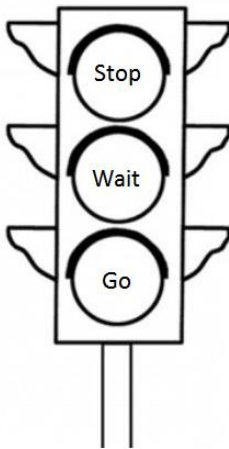


Crossing the Street

A traffic light uses red, yellow, and green to tell cars when to Stop, Wait, or Go. Color the traffic light. STOP signs are always red. Color the stop sign. Pedestrian lights show when to walk and when to wait. Color the top man red and the bottom man green.
